Derby City Council has agreed to increase the price of school meals from Monday 20 April 2009 by 15p and by a further 15p from Monday 2 November 2009. This means that after Easter the cost of school meals will go up to £1.85 and after Autumn Half Term they will cost £2.00.

The cost of school meals for the next half term will be £9.25 per week, or if you pay termly the cost will be £46.25. Please make cheques payable to Derby City Council.
